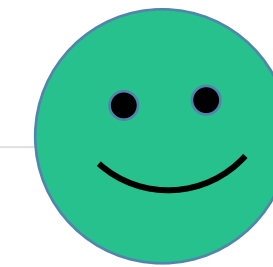
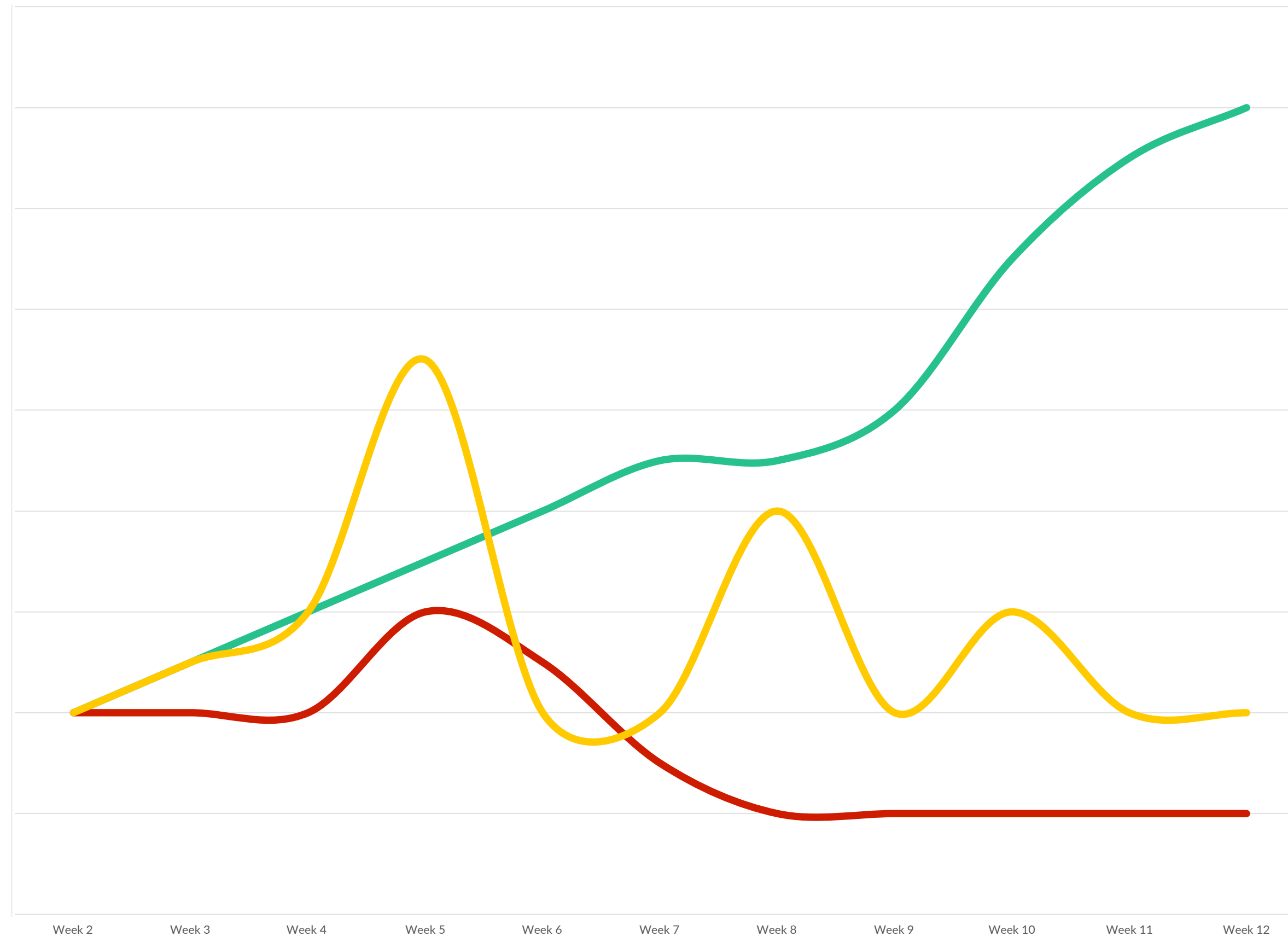


Unique Accountability Dynamic

1. OKRs topic in weekly huddle → #1 predictor of outcomes
2. Authentic key results and retros
3. Embrace transparency as a team virtue
4. Hold each other accountable and cheer each other on
5. Appreciate the difference between activity and results, and the autonomy and empowerment that creates
6. Build bridges across organization, often with shared OKRs

% Result Achievement



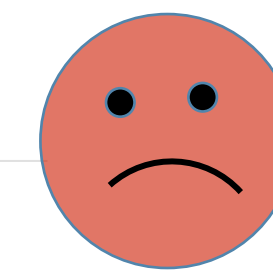
Sustained weekly results focus

- Part of manager's leadership habit
- Weekly updates keep results top of mind
- High transparency, early risk detection so not lost time



Haphazard focus

- Distraction for 1-3 weeks at a time
- Sudden realization off course, not enough time to recover
- Not part of team or management habits



Set and forget

- No focus once set
- Lost opportunity for success, set up for failure
- Lost confidence in management and overall objectives
